Buses make great secondary support, but they're not the spine needed to handle the heavy lifting on our community's King Street-401-Hespeler Road transit corridor.

Putting in a bus-only solution today would mean painful surgery in ten years to reinforce it with rail. Starting now with an LRT spine gives us the best chance to reach Cambridge in the same ten-year time-frame, without building the system twice.

At the cost of half a tank of gas per household per year, Light Rail Transit is a robust solution at an affordable price. So why isn't the entire community behind it?

Instead of a healthy spine, anti-transit naysayers want band-aid solutions. Without LRT, patchwork road widening would carve into our land, our homes, and demand back-breaking road taxes.
